

Soap saver pouches

Tunisian crochet



You will need:

5mm hook

Cotton yarn in any colours

30-40g in total
(Drops Paris 100% cotton)

Needle

Abbreviations:

Ch = chain

TSS = Tunisian slip stitch

TPS = Tunisian purl stitch

TKS = Tunisian knit stitch

YO = Yarn over

Note:



You can use these as a chance to practice a new stitch. Make a sampler that is approximately 14cm by 30cm and finish as per the instruction below.



2 colour:

Foundation row:

Using colour A ch 22. Pick up loops from the back bumps of the chain. Use colour B for return pass.

Row 1

In B TSS to end, Return in A

Row 2:

In A TSS to end, Return in B

Repeat for 30 rows

Massage:

Foundation row:

Ch 22, Pick up loops from back bumps of the chain. Return.

Rows 1 – 8:

TSS to end, return.

Row 9:

TSS 2, bobble stitch [*yo, TKS, yo, pull through 2. Repeat from *3more times into same stitch, yo pull through 4 loops], TSS 4, bobble stitch, TSS 4, bobble stitch, TSS 4, bobble stitch, TSS 2, work final stitch. Return.

Row 10:

Tss to end, Return.

Row 11:

TSS 4, bobble, TSS, 4, bobble, TSS 4, bobble, TSS to end. Return

Row 12:

Tss to end. Return.

Row 13:

Repeat row 9

Rows 14 – 30

TSS to end. Return.



Exfoliating:

Ch 22, Pick up loops from back bumps of the chain. Return.

Work 30 rows of honeycomb stitch.



“Lathery”:

Ch 32, Pick up loops from back bumps of the chain. Return.

Work 18-20 rows of 1x1 ribbing. [TKS 1, TPS 1]



Finishing:

Fold the rectangle shape right sides together with an overlap of about 6-7 rows.

Sew along the top and bottom and then turn right side out
